The annual exam in Islamabad has been secured through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between EBR and RSP, guaranteeing access at least through 2027.

4. Proven Impact: Insights from the 2024 Session

In April 2024, the fifth official EDiR session was held in Islamabad at the FAST National University. Key outcomes included:

5. Special Conditions for Pakistani Candidates

To support local uptake, the EBR has introduced a **reduced fee and educational package** for candidates in Pakistan:

- **Reduced exam fee:** €990 (standard €1,100)

- **Two Self-Assessment Tools** (worth €15 each)

These benefits are available to candidates who register early and take the exam in Islamabad.



6. Eligibility Criteria (Adapted for Pakistan)

Applicants must be certified radiologists or in their final year of national radiology training. Specific documentation for Pakistani candidates includes:

- Option 1: FCPS or MD degree
- Option 2: MCPS/DMRD + 2 years as supervised radiologist
- Option 3: IMM Certificate + 4 years FCPS Part-II training

Additional requirements:

- Proof of profession from current employer
- Membership proof from the Radiological Society of Pakistan (RSP)
- Copy of passport

7. Looking Ahead: Strategic Partnership with RSP

The collaboration between EBR and RSP marks a long-term investment in elevating radiology education in Pakistan. Under the current MoU:

- One EDiR session is scheduled yearly in Islamabad
 - Technical standards and supervision are ensured by RSP and EBR teams
